



RULES & PROCEDURES **MAY 28-29-30, 2021**

COVID-19 PROCEDURE – There will be no paperwork processed at the track. **All WAIVERS and APPLICATIONS** must be completed with signature in advance and submitted electronically. Scanned, PDF or faxed documents are acceptable (no photos). Documents, completed and pre-signed will also be accepted at the track.

COVID-19 PROCEDURE – Drivers and crew must respect the following before arrival:

1. If you are considered “high risk” stay home
2. If you feel sick before arriving stay home
3. If you do not feel safe participating at events which permit public gathering stay home
4. You are willing to respect all procedural and social practice guidelines.

If you start to feel sick while at the track, notify the medical staff and go home. A non-contact infrared forehead thermometer will be available for testing.

COVID-19 PROCEDURE – Only essential crew who have been approved and confirmed in advance will be permitted entry. No sign up will be accepted at the track.

COVID-19 PROCEDURE – Drivers and crew must bring:

1. Face mask
2. Hand sanitizer
3. Any additional Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) they feel necessary

COST

A) **Entry fee: \$ 500.00** per day, per driver – Accepted payment: credit card, cheque or money order must accompany the entry form and payable to: **C.M.T. Events 2002 Inc.**

B) Each entry will permit 1 driver and one (1) crew member.

PADDOCK AND PARKING

COVID-19 PROCEDURE - Gates to the track will close at 8:30pm each night.

Paddock space is limited. An area will be reserved in the paddock (P1) for each track car. The only vehicles allowed in (P1) will be the trailer and the tow vehicle provided the (tow vehicle) fits within your allotted space.

COVID-19 PROCEDURE - The circuit reserves the right to pre-designate paddock spaces and other areas. All truck/trailer/awning set ups must have a minimum distance of 5 meters (15ft) between the next nearest participant's truck/trailer/awning set up.

COVID-19 PROCEDURE – Drivers and crew must practice social distancing at all times and not stand closer than 2 meters (6ft) apart.

COVID-19 PROCEDURE – Participants and crew must wear a protective face mask at all times. This includes when outside their designated paddock space, visiting the restrooms, administrative tent and/or whenever a 2 meter (6ft) separation is not possible.

Motorhomes and Toterhomes will be allowed in the paddock (P1) for a \$ 200.00 fee provided it is the tow vehicle and paid in advance with the application

General camping is permitted for motorhomes and/or campers in (P2) for a \$ 100.00 fee (no services).

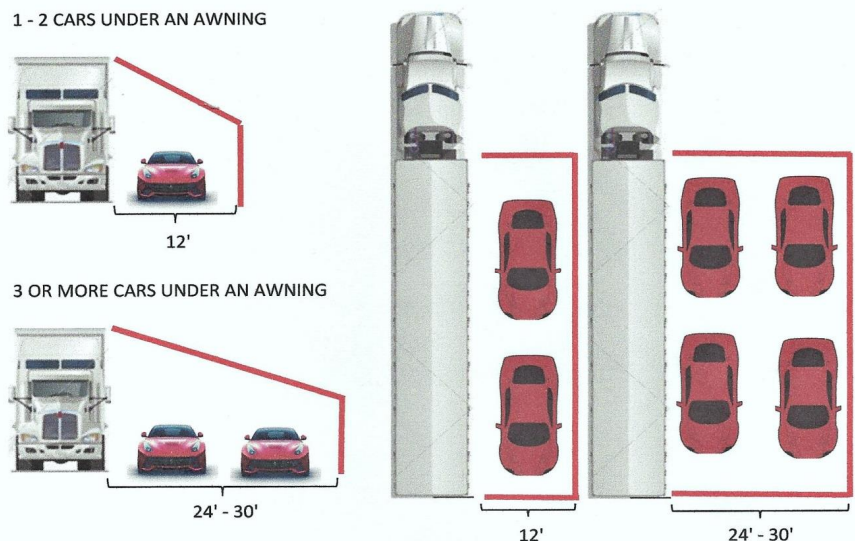
COVID-19 PROCEDURE – The curfew requires participants to remain in their accommodation between 9:30pm and 5:00am

COVID-19 PROCEDURE – Motorhomes / RVs / Travel Trailers must be self-contained and equipped with a washroom. Restroom facilities at Circuit Mont-Tremblant will close at 5:00pm each day.

COVID-19 PROCEDURE – Overnight occupation is limited only to persons who reside at the same address.

All teams, including drivers and crew, will receive (P2) parking passes.

Limits to the acceptable paddock space, awnings and/or tents size permitted for one & two car entrants will be established and enforced. Entrants with oversized awnings are encouraged and may be obliged to partner with other participants in order to maximize their requested paddock space. Entrants will not be permitted to extend their awning if it exceeds their allotted space.



All participants are required to comply with directions given by paddock Marshalls.

Excessive speed in the paddock and/or failure of drivers and crews to obey the paddock Marshall's instructions may result in exclusion.

It is strictly forbidden to dispose of motor oil anywhere in the paddocks. Specially marked containers will be available for that purpose. Any breach of this regulation will be punishable by a fine and/or exclusion from Circuit Mont Tremblant property at the discretion of the organizers. It is forbidden to leave tires on the property.

PITS

COVID-19 PROCEDURE – Drivers and crew are required to wear a protective face mask, and respect social distancing in the pits.

Drivers and crew members with proper credentials will only be allowed in the pit area during their own sessions. Regulations concerning the behavior of crew members in the pit area will be strictly implemented.

Drivers and crew members must comply with the applicable clothing regulation. Long pants and closed shoes are required in the pit lane area.

A black flag with an orange circle (meat ball) could be shown at corner 8. A driver receiving this warning must enter the pit lane immediately without completing another lap.

Children under 16 years of age will not be permitted in the pit lane area.

It is forbidden to smoke in pit lane area.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

COVID-19 PROCEDURE – Control tower restroom facility – will be open to one (1) person at a time. You will be required to wear a face mask. Follow posted directions, sanitary procedures and respect social distancing guidelines at all times.

All participants are expected to observe the quiet hours 20h00 – 08h00. No running of engines prior to 08:00h and after 17h00.

ELIGIBILITY OF CARS

All drivers attest that their car(s) comply with the general rules and safety specifications in accordance with the FIA International Sporting Code, and the Sports Development Group (GDS) Sporting Code. Vehicles may be subject to inspection at anytime by a designated Circuit Mont Tremblant Official. Circuit Mont Tremblant reserves the right to exclude any vehicle from participation that it deems, inappropriate or unsafe, or does not meet acceptable standards.

IDENTIFICATION ON CARS

It is the responsibility of the drivers to insure that their car numbers can easily be read by officials, the organizers can demand that these numbers be altered if their visibility is not clear.

EXTERNAL CAMERA

Sedans – No externally mounted cameras are permitted. Cameras must be mounted inside the car.

Open Cockpit – Externally mounted cameras must be mechanically attached (no magnets) and have a secondary back up, mechanically tethered to the chassis.

REMOTE CONTROLLED UAV/DRONE – The use of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV), also known as drones for any purpose whatsoever is prohibited on Circuit Mont Tremblant property.

USE OF IMAGES – Drivers and on behalf of their crew and/or guests agree to use photo images and video footage taken at Circuit Mont Tremblant responsibly. Any images/footage taken is strictly for personal use only and not to be used for any commercial purposes. If images/footage includes imagery of an accident you must make such images/footage available to Circuit Mont Tremblant and agree NOT to post images/footage on any social media site including but not limited to You Tube, Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn, Twitter, Flickr, Tumblr, Snapchat or any other similar site. If said images/footage should appear on such media the participant agrees to compensate Circuit Mont Tremblant accordingly.
